



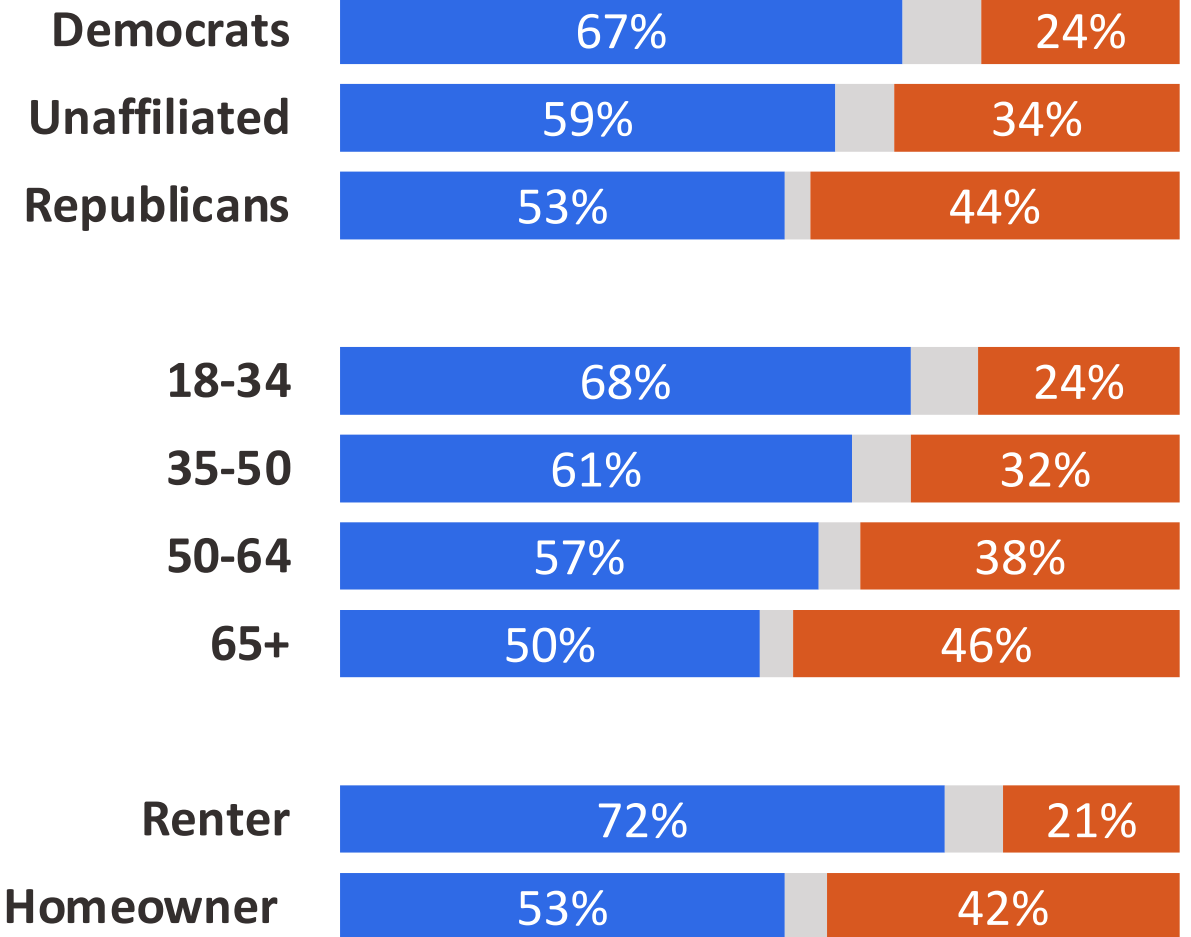
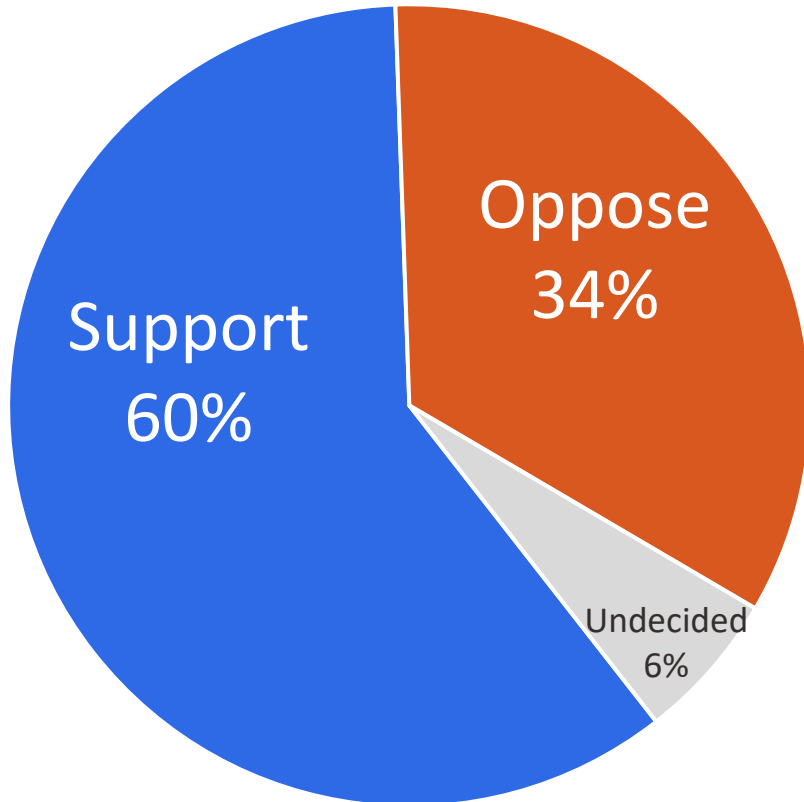
# Healthier Colorado Healthy Air and Water Colorado Statewide Poll – Housing

*February 3, 2023*

*These results are based on a sample of 1008 online survey respondents, among registered voters statewide in Colorado. The poll was conducted from January 10-22, 2023 by Keating Research. The worst-case margin of error at the 95% level for the sample of 1008 is plus or minus 3.1%.*

# A majority 6-of-10 voters, support a state law to allow the most affordable types of homes like duplexes and townhomes to be built by eliminating local restrictions

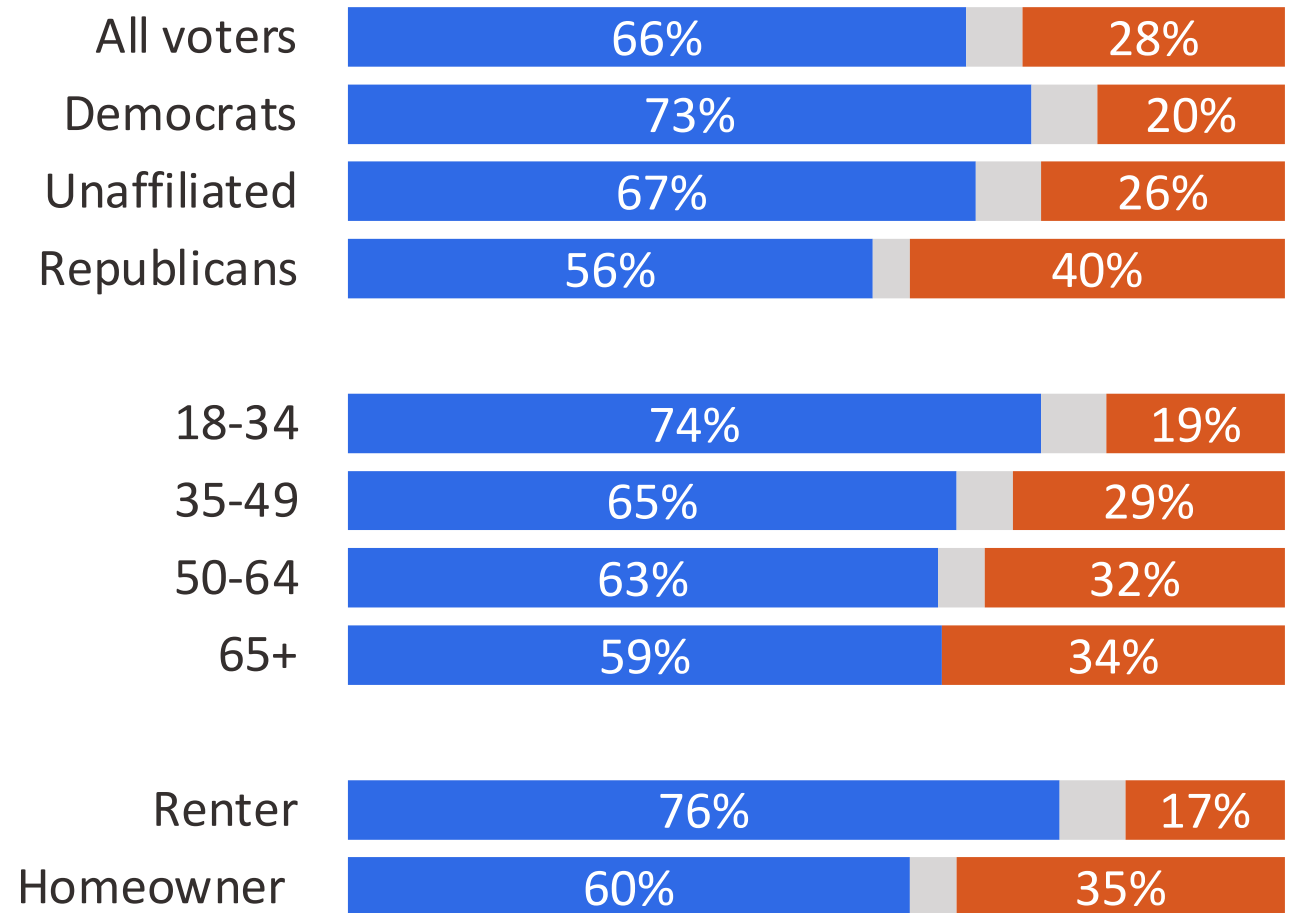
Do you support or oppose a state law that would allow some of the most affordable types of homes, like duplexes, triplexes, and townhomes to be built by eliminating local restrictions?



# Support for the state law increases to 2/3rds with more information about how communities can't build these more affordable types of homes

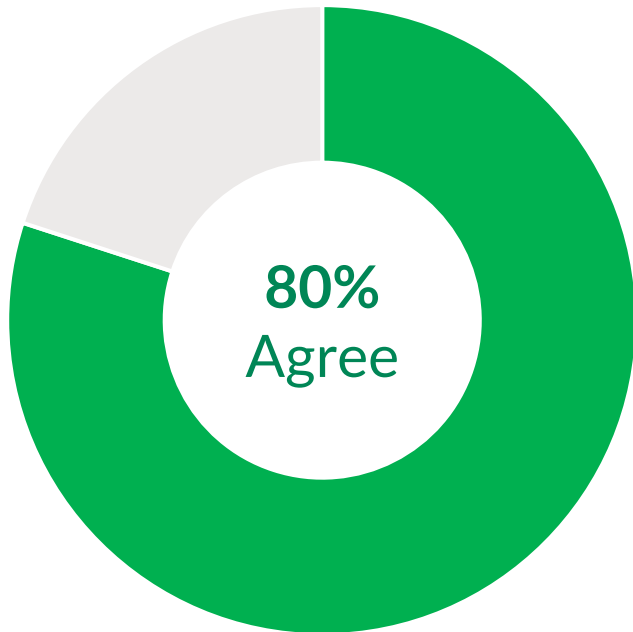
